LOAD : nitrogen – N₂, Compressed

CLASS: 2

Colourless compressed gas
Odourless

NATURE OF DANGER :

Asphyxiant
The gas is suffocating without warning
Heating will cause pressure rise with risk of bursting
Decomposition in a fire : production of toxic fumes

BASIC PERSONAL PROTECTION :

Suitable respiratory protective device

IMMEDIATE ACTION BY DRIVER : Notify police and fire brigade

Stop the engine
No naked lights. No smoking
Mark roads and warn other road users
Keep public away from danger area. Keep upwind
Notify police and fire brigade as soon as possible

ADDITIONAL AND/OR SPECIAL ACTIONS BY THE DRIVER

Any action only if without personal risk
Stop leaks if without risk
Warn everybody in sewers, basements and work pits – Danger of suffocating hazard

FIRE(information for the driver in case of fire)

Do not attempt to deal with any fire involving the load

FIRST AID

Seek medical treatment when anyone has symptoms apparently due to inhalation or contact with skin or eyes

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES

Use water spray to "knock down" vapour
Keep container(s) cool by spraying water if exposed to fire
